



High School Senior Scholarship Application

Thank you for applying for the Compeer Financial High School Senior Scholarship offered by Compeer Financial Fund for Rural America! Compeer is proud to invest \$180,000 toward students' continued education.

PROGRAM: Provides 120 (40 per state) individual \$1,500 scholarships to students within the 144-county services territory in Illinois, Minnesota and Wisconsin of Compeer Financial. The scholarship is for graduating high school seniors who have been accepted or will enroll at a university, college or community/technical college. Eligible applicants will have a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale), reside in Compeer's 144-county services territory, and have a designated agriculture major or interest in an agriculture-related field, or have an agricultural or rural background.

**Dependents of Compeer Financial team members and Board Members are not eligible.*

SELECTION CRITERIA: Selection will be based on a combination of academic achievement, agricultural and community youth organization involvement and essay. Special consideration will be given to students of parents who do business with Compeer Financial. All applicants will be judged by an internal committee of Compeer team members.

DEADLINE: March 16, 2020 (Must be received by)

- A school official needs to enter and verify ACT/SAT Score (if taken), Class Rank, GPA (converted to a 4.0 scale) and Graduation date.
- Prepare Involvement List: Describe your involvement in agricultural, community, volunteer, and work activities and school and extracurricular activities.
- Prepare Goals: Describe your career and personal goals and respond to an essay question related to your impact on rural America.
- Prepare Essay: Choose an essay question from two prompts listed on the application. Write a thoughtful and unique response, aligning with proper grammar and spelling.
- Student must complete, sign and date
- Parent or Legal Guardian must sign and date
- The application must be typed. Only signatures and school official information can be hand written.
