

HOLLIS AND ANNA BOARDMAN SCHOLARSHIP

FOR GRADUATING SENIORS AT RIVERDALE HIGH SCHOOL

This scholarship has been established in memory of Hollis and Anna Boardman and their lifelong commitment to education as a “way of life.” It is hoped that the students who receive this scholarship will not only gain some financial assistance, but will also demonstrate by the quality of their lives, as did the individuals for whom this scholarship is named, the importance learning and the job which comes from sharing one’s knowledge.

CRITERIA

Criteria for selection are as follows, in order of importance:

- 1) Student is to be a graduating senior at Riverdale High School who has been admitted into an accredited school or college for the subsequent semester;
- 2) Preference should be given to students who intend to study some phase of agriculture or home economics or education;
- 3) Qualities to consider in making the final selection include:
 - a) Demonstrated qualities of leadership - student should have been active in leadership roles in school and community organizations;
 - b) This scholarship is seen as a reward to outstanding young people who have demonstrated their commitment to learning and community involvement. Therefore, while financial need might be considered in a final decision, it should not be a primary factor.

PAYMENT

Upon selection, the guidance office will contact Janice Wainwright and she will issue a check payable to the scholarship recipient after confirmation of his/her registration at the college. The amount of the scholarship may vary annually but will not be less than \$250.
