Overview of scholarship criteria, conditions, and instructions presented to the Riverdale Educational Foundation as a guide for awarding this scholarship.

Introduction: Statement of Masonic philosophy to be read each year at Class Night prior to giving the scholarship: (To be presented by a Lodge member if available – contact Todd Jackson. If a Lodge member is not available, a member of the Riverdale Educational Foundation will make the presentation.

One of the basic beliefs of Freemasonry is that each person has a responsibility to help improve society through philanthropy and community service. Helping people is one of the hallmarks of Masons. Principles of Freemasonry include honor, integrity, tolerance, charity, truth, and respect for all.

It was in the spirit of Masonic philosophy and principles that Philo Lodge #436 of Port Byron, Illinois decided, upon its merger with Stewart Lodge #92 of Geneseo, Illinois, to devote the bulk of its remaining assets to the establishment of this scholarship.

#### **Purpose of Scholarship**

To provide assistance to a graduate of Riverdale High School in continuing their education. Money may be used for any legitimate school related expense such as tuition, fees, or books.

#### **Amount**

Annual interest generated on a principal amount of \$40,000. Scholarship award is capped at \$1,500. Any annual interest received above the \$1,500 cap is to be placed in a fund to generate additional scholarships also capped at \$1,500.

A five-year CD was purchased at the Old Farmers and Merchants State Bank, Hillsdale, Illinois in the name of the Riverdale Educational Foundation. The interest will be paid annually into an account designated by the Foundation to provide the money for the annual scholarship.

#### **Eligibility**

Enrolled in a Vocational School, University, or College. Satisfactory evidence of enrollment to be provided to the Riverdale Educational Foundation before the scholarship money is released.

Masonic relationship or membership is not required.

### **Listed Criteria**

Financial need.

Demonstrated record of service to school and community.

Possesses good moral character.

Has demonstrated good citizenship.

Has a sincere desire for continuing education.

Secure application form from Riverdale High School Guidance office. Secure recommendations from three adults (at least two must be teachers at Riverdale.)

Philo Lodge #436 A.F. & A.M., Port Byron, Illinois, upon its merger with Stewart Lodge #92 A.F. & A.M., Geneseo, Illinois, decided to devote the bulk of its remaining assets to the establishment of a scholarship fund for Riverdale High School. The scholarship money will be paid to the student upon recipient's proof of enrollment as a full time student at a Vocational School, University of College. Money may be used for any legitimate school related expense such as tuition, fees, or books.
